"Natural Edge Hi/Low Bark Winged Vase" Mike will bring several finished examples to analyze/discuss, and will demonstrate turning his signature Natural Edge Hi/Low Bark Winged Vase including the points listed below. Mike will provide the "green" natural edge timber.

- 1. Selecting/harvesting natural edge timber.
- 2. Preparing timber with chainsaw and band-saw, and safely mounting on lathe.
- 3. Design strategies: Positioning and balancing timber/bark on lathe to obtain desired design.
- 4. Safely Turning: Tools & grinds, speed, ghost imaging, preventing bark from fracturing and tearing.
- 5. Sculpting/shaping exterior: Directional wing cutting, shaping body and fortifying bark.
- 6. Removing inside material, use of bowl gauge quasi-shear-cut on inside hidden curve vs. hollowing tool, shaping base/foot.
- 7. Discuss Sanding & Finishing.
