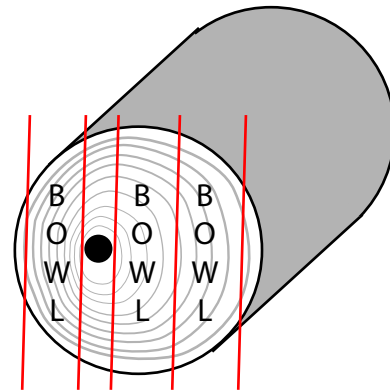
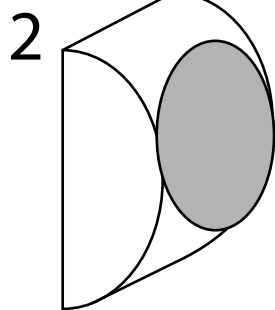
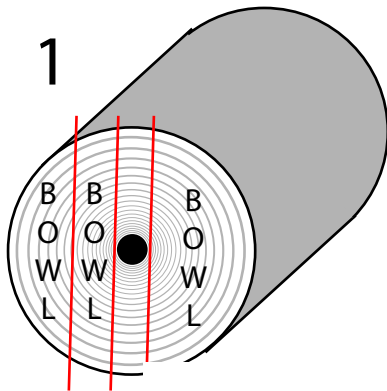


Do not use the pith

 trunk

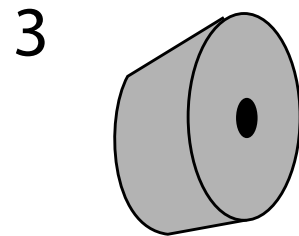


Do not use the pith

 you will have excessive warping

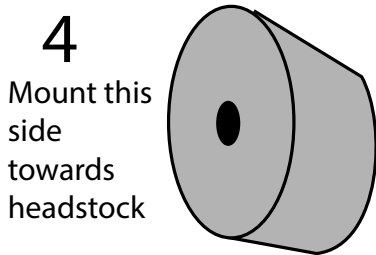
Turning Natural Edge

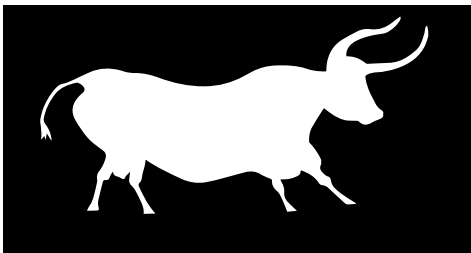

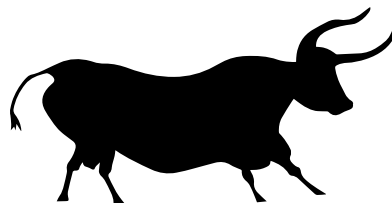

Use this to define POSITIVE space  
 Lay masking tape to stabilize the stencil  
 Peel off the backing and transfer to bowl



Use this to define negative space
