



Do not use the pith Note: Rings of Growth are equally spaced from a trunk




Do not use the pith Note: Rings of Growth are unequally spaced on a branch. This cut has similar ring spacing. If cut at 90° to this, you will have excessive warping

## **Turning Natural Edge**





Use cardboard cut out on this side as a guide to cut round.



Mount this side towards headstock

Carve tenon and bottom of bowl on tailstock side Resources & recommendations


